BBM3102 History of Malay Culture

Prerequisite: None

This course emphasizes pre-islamic malay cultural history; malay culture of the islamic era; islamic thought in the malay world; western influence on malay culture; national culture

BBM3104 Classical Malay Language

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course encompasses definition of classical malay; history of classical malay and its manuscript: the development of the classical malay language: early period of the classical malay: sejarah melayu, aqa'id l-nasafi and other early texts; 17th century malay: adat raja-raja melayu, bustanus-salatin,

BBM3105 Philosophy of the Malay Language

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the concept and meaning of philosophy, relationship between language and philosophy, theory of language, meaning and theory of symbolism, history of the philosophy of language, and trends of thought in Malay language research

BBM3106 Linguistic Theory

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the development of linguistics and its significance, traditional grammar, structural and transformational-generative theories, situational context of use, discourse analysis and influence of theories towards the development of Malay linguistics

BBM3107 Introduction to Stylistics

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers language use of different authors, the choice of words, sentence structure, sound quality keywords, and denotative and connotative meaning aspects and impact used in texts

BBM3108 History and Family of Malay Language

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the aspects of etymology and concept of Malay language, Austronesian language family, the origin of the Malay race and language, old Malay, classic Malay, modern Malay, the Malay language in Indonesia, Brunei Darussalam and Singapore, the Malay language and literary manuscripts and texts, Malay language and literary centres

BBM3201 Introduction to General Linguistics

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers definitions of linguistics, language and its characteristics, language as a system of communication and its differences with other systems of communication, basic linguistics and discourse

BBM3202 Phonetics and Phonology of the Malay Language

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the sound system of the Malay language based on the international phonetic alphabet, articulatory phonetics, phonetic transcription of Malay language, segmental sound units, phonemes and distinctive features, theory and application of generative phonology of the Malay Language

BBM3203 Malay Grammar

4(3+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers morphemes and affixes, word classes, nouns, verbs, adjectives, function words, phrases, noun phrases, verb phrases, adjective phrases, conjunction phrases, clauses, simple and compound sentences

BBM3204 Sociolinguistics

4(3+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the definitions of sociolinguistics and the sociology of language, relationship between language, society and its culture and worldviews of language, varieties and language planning

3(3+0)

BBM3205 Introduction to Psycholinguistics

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the history and developments of psycholinguistics, the subtopic within psycholinguistics, linguistic knowledge, theories and levels of language acquisition, second language learning, language and linguistic performance, language and the brain, and language and thought

BBM3206 Semantics

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers concepts and definitions of semantics, semantic theories, relationship between semantics and historical development of linguistics, diversity of meaning, semantic change, situational context of language use, role of non-linguistic behavior, behaviourism in semantics, lexical and grammatical meaning, euphemia and disphemia, semantic fields, and the scope of linguistic and semantic research

BBM3207 Lexicography

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers definitions of concepts that are related to methods and processes in corpus based dictionary making, the role of semantics in lexicography, differences between monolingual and bilingual dictionaries, history of Malay lexicography, types of dictionaries, evaluation and criticism of monolingual and bilingual dictionaries

BBM3209 Introduction to Translation

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the history of translation, concepts, principles and processes involved in translation including analysis, transferring and restructure of the translated texts. Its also includes translation of the elements of the language and contents and evaluation of translated texts

BBM3211 Theory and Practice of Translation

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: BBM3209

This course covers theories of translation, characteristics of dynamic translation, principles of equivalence in translation, translation of translational units, roles of the translator, procedures in translation, principles of translation for academic texts, literary, journalism and scientific texts

BBM3213 Introduction to Sociolinguistics

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the definitions of sociolinguistics and the sociology of language, relationship between language, society and its culture and worldviews of language, varieties and language planning

BBM3214 Malay Grammar

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers word classes: nouns, verbs, adjective, function words, phrases: noun phrases, verb phrases, adjective phrases, conjunction phrases, clauses, simple and compound sentences

BBM3302 Malay Arts

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers definitions and concepts of Malay arts, various branches of arts, channels of arts, arts and education, knowledge and arts, Malay aesthetics, the arts and the artist.

BBM3303 Dialectology and Language Register

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the concepts of language variatio and language change, types of language register, variety, style and dialect, behavioural language use, language contact and factors influencing language variation

BBM3401 Advanced Malay Language

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers aspects and functions of language, language standardization, language as a medium of knowledge, oral and written presentations, and the development of vocabulary

3(3+0)

BBM3402 Jawi Writing System

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the history of Jawi script, the development and the spread of Jawi script, Jawi alphabets and their equivalent in the romanised script, forms of Jawi script, types of Jawi spelling, methods of Jawi spelling, reading and writing exercises in Jawi, and khat scripts

BBM3405 Terminology

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course encompasses basic concept sources of terminology grammatical elements and process in terminology meaning in the formation of terms abbreviated terms and symbols spelling methods in terminology

BBM3406 Academic Writing

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the characteristics and structures of various genres in academic writing, writing process, paragraph pattern, information search, use of references, avoiding plagiarism, and checking the writing

BBM3410 Multimedia In Language

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers components and aspects of development in multimedia, transforming texts to multimedia, collection of information for storyboards, multimedia presentations and the development of an effective language multimedia package

BBM3411 Language Competence

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the concepts, types, principles, and process of acquiring listening, speaking, reading and writing skills, language competence for verbal and written communication

BBM3412 Technology, Information, Language and Literature

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course will give exposure toways and process of doing technology research survey on the development and influence of cross cultural transfer in language and literature in design and product besides developing ways evaluation of electronic application through digital presentation

BBM3413 Research Methodology in Malay Language

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers topics related to concepts, types and methods and procedures in Malay language and linguistic research, statistical analysis and preparation of research proposal

BBM3414 Psycholinguistics Skills for Children

3(1+2)

Prerequisite: BBM3205

This course covers suggested activities for the existing amelioration of deficits in language acquisition and processing information in children based on six major processes of the basic psycholinguistics ability model

BBM3415 Practical Malay Language

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers spoken and written language, single and derivative word. Other aspects of focus is enrichment of words, language politeness, language varieties and language usage in media

BBM4501 Cultural Leadership

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the application of concepts and issues of cultural leadership, issues of cultural management, regulations and laws of consented traditional values, aspects of cultural leadership crossing race and politics, and local and international belief systems

3(2+1)

BBM4903 Industrial Training

12(0+12)

Prerequisite: None

In this course, students will be exposed to real working environment in industries/organizations. Training includes application of the theoretical and practical aspects that have been studied with current practices in the workplace. Problem solving and communication skills are also emphasized

BBM4959 **Bachelor Disertation**

6(0+6)

Prerequisite: BBM3413

This course covers the preparation of proposal, implementation and scientific writing of research project. Scientific approach to generate data systematically through appropriate design, data collection and analysis are emphasized

BBN3202 Linguistics in Interpretation and Translation

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers aspects and role of linguistics in theoretical interpretation and translation using samples of texts as a guide, and the role of linguistics in supporting disciplines like semantics, pragmatics and semiotics in the translation and interpretation of texts

BBN3301 Interpretation and Translation Across Cultures

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers aspects of culture and communication in translation and interpretation, concepts of intercultural and intercommunication the differences and language as communication tool

BBN3401 Theory and Practice in Interpretation

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers basic aspects of interpretation, models of social science interpretation, the process of interpretation and appreciation of the art of interpretation

Computer-Aided Translation BBN3402

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the use of equipments and machines in translation and the evaluation of computer-aided translation.

BBN3403 **Scientific and Technical Translation**

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers issues related to scientific and technical translation, use of modern technology such as translation memory systems, bank of electronic terms and electronic translations

BBN3404 Translation of the Mass Media

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the criterion of language variations, the role of translation in mass media communication, the relationship between translation and mass media communication, the important criteria of translation and variation of media texts and the significant of translation between mass media

BBN3405 Translation In Malay Letters

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the translation of letters based on translation theories and techniques. Discussion encompasses the aspects of sociocultural and comparison of cultures

BBN3406 Audiovisual Translation

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: BBM3209

This course covers professional practice in the field of audiovisual translation, techniques in translating audiovisual products, considerations in audio-visual translation, the linguistics and cultures in audiovisual translation, and the influence of film technology in translation strategies

BBN3407 Translation Quality Assessment

Prerequisite: BBM3209

This course covers translation quality, problems in the assessment of translation quality, criteria of translation quality according to traditional and modern approaches, linguistic and extra-linguistic, factors in translation evaluation, a balanced assessment of translation quality

BBW3101 Critical and Creative Thinking

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course focuses on concepts of critical and creative thinking, perceptions in thinking, functions of Right Brain Hemisphereand Left Brain Hemisphere, and relationship of Right Brain Hemisphere and Left Brain Hemisphere to critical and creative thinking, instruments of thinking and style of critical and creative thinking, and application of critical and creative thinking

BBW3203 The Art of Writing

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

BBW3302 Issues in Publishing

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers issues in printed as well as electronic particularly in scholarly publishing. Discussion has involved various initiatives and acts to ensure publishing activities stay

BBW3401 Analysis and Editing Texts

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the construction and structure of typescript, principles in evaluation and analysis of typescripts, concept, needs and purpose of editing, role of editor, housestyle, and aspects of language in editing are also highlighted

BBW3402 Designing and Publishing

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers theoretical and practical aspects of print publishing, book publishing, book designing, graphic, and publishing matters

BBW3404 Report, Article, and News Writing

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers criteria of a good writing, forms of writing, report writing, writing in the context of discourse development and writing styles, news writing, comprehensive news writing; general news item, complex news items and specialized news items, editing news items, definition and nature of articles; articles formats and technique of article writing

BBW3405 Writing Strategies in Business

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers all aspects in business writing. Focus will be given to writing method related to business management such as working paper, letter writing, copy writing, company profile, and report writing.

BBW3406 Academic Writing

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the characteristics and structures of various genres in academic writing, writing process, paragraph pattern, information search, use of references, avoiding plagiarism, and checking the writing

3(2+1)

BBX3101 Introduction to Theatre

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the ways in which dramatic texts are taken from the page to an audience, the roles of the director, the designer and the actor will be explored, various theatrical styles, traditions and theories of performance

BBX3102 Classical Theatre

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course discuss the history and the existence of world classical theatres and will also focus on the Greek, Japanese, Chinese, Indonesian, and Malaysian theatrical tradition

BBX3103 Modern Western Theatre

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This Course Covers The History And The Factors Of Western Theatre Development With Focus On The Development Of Modern European And American Theatre, And Theatrical And Dramatical Styles

Modern Asian Theatre

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the modern Asian theatre and will approach six texts from a theatrical point of view. Students learn the cultural and historical background of each drama, and then concentrate on theatrical and stylistic conventions of each text

BBX3105 Basic Theatre

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course focuses on basic concepts, development historical, streams in theatre, and approaches in performance. The course also focuses on theatre management and texts reading

BBX3411 **Acting and Improvisation I**

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers on introductory theatre exercise designed to develop an ensemble of physical and vocal expressiveness, sensory awareness, imagination, confidence and spontaneity, foundation of realistic acting techniques using Uta Hagen's object exercise

BBX3412 Acting and Improvisation II

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: BBX3411

The course covers the preparation and performances of two contrasting monologues, methods of characterization, performance concept, methods of textual analysis, and vocalization

BBX3413 **Scene Study**

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers process to perform one classical and one modern scene, development of a working knowledge of structure, blocking, beat analysis, movement, pacing, use of properties and presentation

Methods of Play Production BBX3414

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers creating an original theatrical piece using the elements of acting, movement and direction, music and sound, costume, lighting and set

BBX3415 Solo Performance

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the production of monologues, the craft of original writing personal monologue, and perform the monologue through rehearsal and final performance

Department of English Language

BBI3102 Language Evolution And Change

Prerequisite: None

3(3+0)

This course covers the development of the English language from its Anglo-Saxon roots to its present status as the world's dominant language. It also focusses on social, religious and political factors that have affected the evolution of and changes in the English language.

BBI3201 General Linguistics

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the essential elements of linguistics. It focuses on the nature of language, phonetics and phonology, morphology, syntax, semantics and pragmatics. The course also includes other branches of linguistics.

BBI3202 English Phonetics and Phonology

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers English speech sounds and speech sound patterns. It includes the English vowel and consonant systems, phonetic and phonemic transcriptions, concepts of allophone and phoneme, syllable, segmental features, and connected speech processes. The course also examines problems related to the use of English sounds by different speakers

BBI3207 Rhetoric and Style

3(3+0)

Prerequisite : None

This course covers the theory of rhetoric and style in spoken and written texts. The course also discusses rhetorical strategies such as parody, irony, satire, and humour. It includes use of rhetorical styles and strategies for persuasion and other purposes

BBI3210 Discourse Analysis

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: BBI3427

This course covers the analysis of spoken and written discourse in the English language using suitable approaches to discourse analysis. It explores the ways in which language use varies according to social and interactional contexts. The course also develops skills for analysing different kinds of texts in a variety of genres.

BBI3211 English for Specific Purposes

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the origin and development of English for Specific Purposes (ESP) in the context of applied linguistics. It includes analysis and evaluation of learner needs, methods, development of curriculum, and course design. The course also involves production of appropriate materials for specific purposes.

BBI3212 English Syntax and Morphology

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers discussion on linguistic units and levels of linguistic description. It also includes selected morphological and syntactic concepts. Practical guidance is provided for the analysis of morphological and syntactic structures, and their relationships.

BBI3213 Speech Communication

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers basic concepts and theories of speech communication. It highlights the importance of listening in effective communication. It also involves application of appropriate strategies in various interpersonal and workplace communicative situations

BBI3219 Semantics and Pragmatics

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: BBI3201

This course covers how meaning is structured through language use in context. It discusses dimensions of meaning in language and language use, including approaches to the analysis of meaning of linguistic units at various levels. It includes analysis of various communicative contexts based on semantic and pragmatic principles

BBI3220 Language Acquisition And Learning

Prerequisite : None

This course covers the stages of first and second language acquisition and learning. It discusses the theories and factors involved in these processes. The course also compares the various approaches to language learning.

BBI3221 Language Planning

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers theories and approaches in language planning. It includes issues in language planning, such as selection of national languages, language standardisation and modernisation, elaboration of a code, educational practices, and economic and political implications. Particular attention is given to how linguistically homogeneous societies accommodate linguistic minorities and how multilingual societies cope with linguistic diversity

BBI3225 Corpus Studies In Language Learning

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

The course covers appropriate quantitative and qualitative analytical approaches in relation to corpus linguistics. It includes corpus linguistic analytical procedures used in the study of natural language usage. Emphasis is given to empirical linguistic evidence as a means to make informed decisions on language usage based on concepts and theories in corpus linguistics

BBI3226 Language in Social Contexts

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the relationship between language and the society that uses it, focusing on aspects of language in relation to thought and culture, multilingualism and language and education policy.

BBI3227 Language and Mind

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: BBI3201

This course covers the core concepts in the psychological study of language. It gives an overview of models explaining how the human brain processes language, and the research evidence that informs them. The course also includes topics on language perception and production, language acquisition, bilingualism, and language impairment. It emphasises analytical thinking involving examining and interpreting samples of psycholinguistic data.

BBI3410 Language For Negotiation

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the significant role of language in negotiation, the negotiating process, different strategies and techniques of negotiation, and the optimisation of language skills for effective negotiation. It also provides negotiation practice in various simulated situations

BBI3417 Writing Research Reports

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: BBI4401

This course covers different types and formats of formal research reports, mode and style in report writing. It also covers different aspects of the writing process which include searching for, compiling, synthesising and organising information, citing references, and presenting the written report in its final form

BBI3421 Expository Writing

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the fundamental aspects of expository writing. It includes language and conventions of different text types. The course encompasses the process of writing from generation of ideas, drafting, revising and evaluating texts. It also emphasises the importance of writer, text, and audience interaction for effective writing.

BBI3427 Grammar for Communicative Purposes

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers knowledge of grammatical rules, forms and functions of the English language. It involves explanation of common errors in grammatical forms and functions. It provides practice for accurate use of grammatical forms in various communicative contexts.

3(3+0)

BBI3428 Professional Editing

Prerequisite: BBI3427

This course covers concepts, techniques, and ethical issues related to editing. It provides a practical approach to the improvement of a text, paying particular attention to language, content, style, and organisation of different text types. It also emphasises the processes needed in editing a document for professional purposes.

BBI3429 Technical and Scientific Writing

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: MUET Band 4

The course covers various types of technical and scientific writing which are relevant for academic and professional needs. It includes the use of language and style of technical and scientific writing for different audiences. Attention is also given to the techniques of reviewing and editing for cohesion and coherence

BBI3431 Business Communication In English

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers communication theories, models and principles for effective oral and written communication in various business settings. It includes intercultural dimensions in business and workplace communication contexts. The course also emphasizes practice in writing various documents and examines methods of organising and developing effective professional business communication styles.

BBI3432 Writing for The Web

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers essential elements in writing for the Web and rhetorical modes used for various Web genres. The course also includes the purposes and functions of different types of Web-based environment, the needs of different Web audiences, and the appropriateness of Web-based content.

BBI3433 Materials Design And Production

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the process of materials design and production for the learning of English, and theories underpinning development of learning materials. It also focusses on the practical aspects of materials production, and the assessment of learning materials. The course involves hands-on design and development of learning materials in various forms.

BBI3434 Language Test Design And Construction

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers fundamental concepts of language testing. It involves the operationalisation of the construct of language competence, application of the principles in the design and construction of English language test items and various skill-based language tests. It also includes a critical analysis and review of language test items and standardised language tests, with particular emphasis on test validity and test design integrity

BBI3436 Critical And Creative Thinking In Language And Communication 3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course examines the techniques and processes in critical and creative thinking related to language and communication. It focuses on developing critical and creative thinking skills necessary to analyse and solve problems. The course emphasises skills needed in making decisions, implementing strategies and formulating well-supported points of view on key academic, social and professional issues in a variety of spoken and written discourses in English.

BBI3437 Approaches to Developing Language Skills

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

The course covers theories and approaches for developing listening, speaking, reading and writing (LSRW) competencies, emphasising the importance of these competencies for communication. It also focusses on planning, designing and implementing appropriate activities and materials for the learning of LSRW across a variety of communicative contexts.

3(2+1)

BBI3501 Special Topic In English Language Studies

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course addresses specialised content or specific topics of current interest in English language studies that are not covered in other courses in the curriculum. The course examines content, themes and issues related to the topic, drawing upon relevant resources. An informed perspective on the topic is obtained through a critical exploration of specific aspects.

BBI4903 Industrial Training

12(0+12)

Prerequisite: None

In this course, students will be exposed to real working environment in industries/organizations. Training includes application of the theoretical and practical aspects that have been studied with current practices in the workplace. Problem solving and communication skills are also emphasized

BBI4201 Media Literacies

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the impact of media culture and practices on society, the development of ICT and other media forms, and resultant changes in language and literacy skills. Social, economic and ideological agenda in media texts and messages are examined alongside the use of verbal and nonverbal elements in constructing meaning

BBI4401 Research Methods for Language Studies

4(3+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers research concepts, methods and methodologies in language-related fields. The course discusses types of research method, research design and procedures, instrumentation, and data analysis. The course requires teamwork and hands-on practice (in the library and computer lab) on the use of relevant literature review and data analysis software. Practice is provided in the preparation of research proposals.

BBI4402 Functional Analysis of Language Use

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: BBI3212

This course covers understanding and application of the principles of the functional grammar approach in the analysis of language in use, both spoken and written. It includes conceptualising word classes, the composition of the clause, and the analysis of information structure. It also focuses on the consolidation of the three strands of meta-functional analyses to explain particular instances of language use

BBI4959 Bacelor Dissertation

6(0+6)

Prerequisite: BBI4401 dan BBI3417

This course covers the preparation of proposal, implementation and scientific writing of research project. Scientific approach to generate data systematically through appropriate design, data collection and analysis are emphasized.

BBL3101 A Survey Of Prose Forms And Poetry In English

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers major trends in the development of literature from the old English period to the twenty first century. It also traces the development and characteristics of various literary forms, and their historical and social influence on selected literary texts.

BBL3102 Introduction To The History Of English Literature

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the origins of the English language, the Indo-European family of languages, Old English, Middle English, Modern English, and the influence of social, religious and political factors on the general development of the English language.

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BBL3103 Literary Theory From Plato To T. S. Eliot

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers representative works of literary criticism from the classical antiquity era to the early 20th century. It includes an investigation of the history of the creative writer's role and its function in society, the changing patterns in aesthetic practices, relationships between literature and society, psychology of art and questions of form and style, and explication of the origins, causes, and connections of literature through a concentrated focusing on major critics.

BBL3211 New Literatures in English

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course traces the development of recent literary trends in new literatures in English and analyses original and translated works in English by Asian, African, Australian, Canadian, Caribbean, South American and Indian writers

BBL3212 Studies In Comparative Literature

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers different genres in world literature in relation to the theory and treatment of literary texts for comparative study together with an in-depth study on a number of literary texts from various literary traditions. The course also focuses on the treatment of themes, writing styles and literary elements.

BBL3213 European Literature in English

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the development of the European literary tradition in relation to major historical events. It also involves a survey of significant works by major European writers

BBL3215 Contemporary Literature in English

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the development of contemporary literature in English and the study of its characteristics as well as an analysis of works from different genres – novel, drama, short story, and poetry by authors' representative of the contemporary period

BBL3218 Children's Literature

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers classics of children's literature in the historical context; types and genres of children's literature, changes in standards and tastes, and contemporary children's literature which include journals, libraries, prizes, media, translation, censorship and applications of children's literature

BBL3220 Classics In Translation

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers major world classics translated into English from different genres. Selected texts are chosen from the Oriental as well as Occidental traditions, from Sanskrit epics Ramayana and Mahabharata and the Persian framework story Arabian Nights Entertainment to the epics of Homer and Virgil, plays of Aeschylus, Sophocles and Euripides, Asian classics as Farid Ud-din Attar's The Conference of the Birds and Khalil Gibran's The Prophet, and modern European classics such as Gustave Flaubert's Madame Bovary and Tolstoy's War and Peace.

BBL3221 South and Southeast Asian Literature in English

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers literatures in English by writers from Singapore, the Philippines, Malaysia, India, Pakistan, and Sri Lanka; the position of English and English writings in these countries; the ways in which English has been used to construct or reconstruct history, myth, and identity; responses of the writers to the fast-changing ethos of modernisation; and an investigation of issues such as multicultural living, personal and political identity, and the position of women in selected texts.

BBL3223 Asian Literature

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers representative works of classical and modern literature from China, India, Indonesia, Japan, and Malaysia. The course examines distinctive social and historical backgrounds of selected texts and comparative analysis both within the non- Western tradition and in juxtaposition to Western thinking, and explication of such pertinent issues as nationalism, imperialism and imperial experience, religion, colonisation, modernisation, and the role of women in individual texts

BBL3224 Literature, Film, And Media

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers literature and film through a comparative analysis of different types of media – the verbal and the visual, the sequential and the synchronic, narrative and dramatic divergences as well as film adaptations of books, and inter-textual borrowing from film techniques into fiction. This course also examines examples of a variety of films.

BBL3225 Anglo-Irish Literature: 1890 To The Present

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers a wide selection of important Irish writings in English, from the 1890s until the present day. The course will critically analyse established works by well-known playwrights, poets and novelists expressing the quintessence of Irish culture and society, and studies the theatrical works of Oscar Wilde and Bernard Shaw through modernist innovators like James Joyce and W.B. Yeats to leading contemporary Irish writers such as Brian Moore, and Nobel Laureate Seamus Heaney.

BBL3227 Images Of The City In Literature

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the classic, modern, and post-modern responses to the city in respective genres of literature which includes poetry, drama, short stories, and the novel. This course also explores generic types from utopian fantasy to portrayals of the urban scene as dystopian nightmare and analysis of themes as reflected in the literary modes of realism allegory, gothic, surrealism, and meta fiction.

BBL3228 Issues And Approaches In Contemporary Literary Theory

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers modern literary theories from 1900 to the present; continuities and discontinuities between the "old" criticism and modern/post-modern literary theory and practice. It focuses on providing students with a basic grasp of terminology of literary analysis; methods of literary research, and an understanding of the nature of literary thinking and language through critical essays.

BBL3229 British Literature

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course surveys the development of the British Literature from the Romantic Period to the Modern Age. It

covers the changes and continuities of the British thought and their aesthetic practices; and major themes and issues related to socio-cultural aspects of these periods from the industrial movement to the end of the modern era through selections of established works by writers representative of the periods.

BBL3230 American Literature

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers selected masterpieces of American literature that reflect major historical events and literary movements on American soil, literature of the Colonies and the New Republic, Romanticism, Transcendentalism, Realism, the Modern Period: 1900 to 1945 and the Contemporary Period: 1945 to the present. The course also looks at important themes in American Literature in relation to the gains and losses of the mythic system referred to as The American Dream and the characteristics of the representative prose and poetry of the periods.

BBL3231 Literature And The Environment

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers an overview of literature and its relationship to the environment. It introduces students to the history, theory and practice of environmental criticism. Through the application of ecocritical methods to literary texts ranging from Romantic poetry to contemporary poetry and fiction, the course surveys how literature represents environmental issues such as animal rights, environmental politics, imperialism, justice, sustainability and ethics.

BBL3326 Literature and Gender

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers a study of the stereotypes of men, women and their sexuality in literature, images of their roles in family, education, work, play, and creativity. It explores the masculine and feminist critique, men and women as readers/men and women as writers/men and women in popular culture and film. The course also surveys of landmark texts in masculine and feminist polemics of the 19th and 20th centuries, an analysis of literary form, theme, style, and voice in representations of men, women and their sexuality in novels, short stories, poetry, and plays, and an emphasis on text from the early decades of the 20th century known as 'the Progressive Era' to the present time.

BBL4306 Literature of Malaysia

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers an overview of literary Malaysian writers in different genres, and in-depth understanding of selected texts.

BBL4401 Play Production and Performance Techniques

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers acting and dramatization techniques, and practical experience in stage craft which includes the fundamentals of directing, stage management, lighting design, scene design, costume design and make-up for production.

BBL4403 Kaedah Penyelidikan dalam Kesusasteraan

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the content, form, and style of academic papers in literature, including basic research strategies using both text and electronic sources directly applicable to literary studies. It also involves the practice in writing papers about fiction, drama, and poetry with emphasis on similarities and differences in writing about the three genres.

BBL4308 Shakespeare and His Contemporaries

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers a survey of William Shakespeare's and his contemporaries' plays during the Elizabethan period in order to illustrate their global significance and current trends

BBL3404 Analysing Novels And Short Stories

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the development of novels and short stories in English. It involves investigation of the nature of each genre. It also highlights the analysis of structure, literary techniques, and critical analysis of social order and values in selected works.

BBL3405 Writing About Literature

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers approaches to critical appreciation of literary texts and analysis of selected literary texts from different literary traditions. The course also looks into responses to literature through principles of writing.

BBL3406 Analysing Poetry and Drama

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers a general survey of the poetical forms and modes of drama from different literary traditions; appreciation of poetry and drama as forms of literary art; critical analysis, and literary appreciation of works of major writers in poetry and drama. It also focuses on the appraisal of strengths and weaknesses of selected texts for comparison and contrast.

BBL3407 Composition And Creative Writing

3(2+1)

Prasyarat : Tiada

This course covers guidelines for creative writing, understanding structure and style of the various genres, understanding the audience writing and editing of short stories, poems and scripts.

BBL3501 Special Topic In Literary Studies In English

3(2+1)

Prerequisite : None

This course focuses on selected issues and trends related to the field of English Literature. Exploration of key issues and new direction is conducted through analysis of critical issues and problems to recommend solutions

BBL4903 Industrial Training

12 (0+12)

Prerequisite: None

In this course, students will be exposed to real working environment in industries/organizations. Training includes application of the theoretical and practical aspects that have been studied with current practices in the workplace. Problem solving and communication skills are also emphasized.

BBL4959 Bachelor's Dissertation

6(0+6)

Prasyarat : Tiada

This course covers the preparation of proposal, implementation and writing of literary research project. Literary approach to interpret data systematically through critical theories and textual analysis are emphasized

Department of Foreign Language

BBA3101 History of Arabic Grammar

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers rise and development of Arabic grammar, views and roles of major schools, comparison of views and contribution of the Arabic grammarians towards the advancement of Arabic linguistics

BBA3201 Arabic Phonetics and Phonology

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers Arabic phonetic and phonology, sound system, sound production, phoneme, vowel, consonant, word, syllable, intonation, stress, pause and stop

BBA3206 Arabic Sociolinguistics

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers relation between language and society, language variation, monolingualism, bilingualism and multilingualism, taboo and eufemisme in language use, and effect of culture on the thinking process and linguistic development of Arabic language

BBA3209 Arabic Rhetoric

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

Kursus ini merangkumi konsep retorik Arab, sejarah, prinsip, pembahagian, gaya, fungsi dan tokoh retorik Arab This course covers concept of Arabic rhetoric, history, principle, type, style, function and great figures of Arabic rhetoric

BBA3211 Arabic Lexicography

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

Kursus ini merangkumi konsep dan peranan perkamusan Arab dan pencarian sumber rujukan maklumat Arab di perpustakaan, teori dan aliran dalam penyusunan kamus Arab serta kepelbagaian cara dalam menyusun kamus Arab

This course covers the concept and role of Arabic lexicography and information search resource in the library, theories and trends in the composition of Arabic dictionary and different methods of dictionary writing

BBA3212 Research Methodology

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers research concept, approach and research design, preparation of instrument, process of data collection and analysis, and preparation of proposal

BBA3213 Arabic Syntax 1

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers sentence components and elements, grammatical rules and methods of analysis, the application of the methods through exercise on analyzing different syntactical components within sentences and paragraphs

BBA3214 Arabic Syntax II

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers Arabic grammatical systems, vocabulary, prefix predicate and deletion of subject and predicate, types of sentences, types of subjects, doer scenario, object and exclamation, word classes, af'al altafdhil and af'al al-ta'ajjub, specification, exemption and derivative nouns, verbs and proper nouns

BBA3216 Arabic Morphology

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers derivation and inflection that constitute main characteristics of Arabic language, forming of word and sentence, application of derivation and inflection in formation of nouns and verbs

BBA3218 Language of the Quran and Hadith

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers introduction to the Quran and Hadith, role of the Quran and Hadith as main sources of Arabic, linguistic features of the Quran and Hadith, contribution of the Quran and Hadith towards development of Arabic in the past and present

BBA3219 Arabic Semantics and Pragmatics

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers concept and scope of semantics and pragmatics, correlation between semantics and pragmatics, function of semantics and pragmatics in understanding linguistics elements and language meanings

BBA3305 Arabic Pycholinguistics

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers relation of language with psychology, mind and language, language acquisition, comprehension and language production, psychology principles for language proficiency, language anxiety and language disorder

BBA3321 Aqidah and Fiqh Discourse

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers concept and principle of fiqh and aqidah discourse in learning Arabic, language element and register, Arabic terminology in the field of fiqh and aqidah

BBA3322 Quranic and Hadith Discourse

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers introduction to science of tafseer and Hadith interpretation, method of tafseer and Hadith interpretation, language register, classical and contemporary tafseer, inimitability of al-Quran and Hadith

BBA3323 Seerah and Ethical Discourse

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers special feature of seerah, life of Prophet Muhammad SAW based on classical and modern text, language in seerah discourse, ethics and politeness pattern, relationship of language and ethics

BBA3409 Theory and Practice of Translation

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers theories and techniques of translation, importance of translation, process and product, commercialization, types of translation, influence of culture on translation, drills in translation

BBA4215 Arabic Syntax III

3(2+1)

Prerequisitet: BBA3214

This course covers further discussions on syntax to complete the methods covered in the previous levels, different types of sentences in Arabic, syawahid and rules of each syntactic method

BBA4304 Rhetorical Inimitability of the Qur'an

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers inimitability concept of the Qur'an, category, characteristic, aspects of syntax, morphology and rethoric, and comparison between Quranic language and Arabic text

BBA3411 Arabic for Specific Purposes

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers use of Arabic text for purposes related to religion, commerce, tourism, academia, and vocabulary enrichment in various entreprenuership fields, verbal and written

BBA3412 Arabic Language in Information Technology

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers computer-assisted reading Arabic, using IT for development of learning efficiency, using multimedia for development of Arabic and smart learning through information highway

BBA3415 Arabic Competency

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers concepts and practices of listening, reading, speaking and writing, language reinforcement exercise, text comprehension, use of intonation and stress

BBA3416 Advanced Arabic Competency

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: BBA3415

This course covers advanced practical aspects of listening, reading, speaking and writing, language reinforcement exercise, text comprehension, verbal and written presentation for academic and professional purposes

BBA4903 Industrial Training

12 (0+12)

Prerequisite: None

In this course, students will be exposed to real working environment in industries/organizations. Training includes application of the theoretical and practical aspects that have been studied with current practices in the workplace. Problem solving and communication skills are also emphasized

BBA4959 Bachelor Dissertation

6(0+6)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the preparation of proposal, implementation and scientific writing of research project. Scientific approach to generate data systematically through appropriate design, data collection and analysis are emphasized

BBA4402 Advanced Theory and Practice of Translation

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: BBA3409

This course covers theories and techniques of translation, translation as process and product, translator requirement and infrastructure, equivalence and translation loss, meaning and grammatical issues, importance of writing skills and knowledge of Arabic rhetorical sciences, drills in translation

BBC3103 Development of Modern Chinese Literature

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the study of Chinese Modern Literature from 1919 – 1949, characteristics of each literary genre, group and literary organizations, prominent writers, prominent works, the status and influences led by prominent writers and their works in the history of Modern Chinese Literature

BBC3104 Malaysian Chinese Literature

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the development of Mahua literature from the period of peranakan literature, classical literature, and the vernacular literature initiated in 1919 to recent years, Chinese literature in Singapore until 1965, various literary trends, schools of thought and literary polemics, prominent literary figures as well as analysis and appreciation of selected Mahua texts

BBC3105 Historical Survey of China

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers history of China from ancient times to the Qing dynasty, and the history after the establishment of Republic of China including political, social and economy as well as scientific and technological achievements at various stages, and the major events and contributions of prominent historical figures

BBC3106 Chinese Literature from Pre-Qin to Weijin Nanbei Dynasties

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the study of development of Chinese literature from Pre-Qin to Weijin Nanbei dynasties, characteristics and types of each genre, prominent writers and works from each dynasty

BBC3107 Chinese Literature from Tang to Qing Dynasties

3(3+0)

Prasyarat : BBC3106

Kursus ini merangkumi pengajian terhadap perkembangan kesusasteraan Cina pada pelbagai dinasti dari dinasti Tang hingga dinasti Qing, ciri dan bentuk setiap genre, sasterawan dan karya terkemuka dari setiap dinasti This course covers the study of development of Chinese literature in different dynasties from Tang to Qing dynasties, characteristics and types of each genre, prominent writers and works from each dynasty

BBC3108 Selected Text of Confucianism

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the philosophical thoughts of Confucianism. Selected Confucian classic will be discussed from the aspects of version and edition, philosophical thought, themes, language style, as well as narrative art

BBC3109 Selected Text of Taoism

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the philosophical thoughts of Taoism. Selected Taoist classic will be discussed from the aspects of version and edition, philosophical thought, themes, language style, as well as narrative art

BBC3206 Introduction to Chinese Translation

3 (3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the different theories and techniques used in translation, issues related to translation, application of appropriate theories in their translation

BBC3209 Chinese Linguistics

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the study of theory and basic knowledge of Chinese linguistics such as development of language, language use, language acquisition, semantics, comparison of languages, language phenomena, branches of linguistics, latest trends in linguistic studies

BBC3210 Comparison of Languages

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the studies on theory and method of language comparison, to compare Mandarin languages with other languages from various aspects, to apply the comparison method in related language fields

BBC4211 Sociolinguistics

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers aspects on the study of sociolinguistic theory; understand the relationship between society and language; study the society changes and their impact to language; describe various phenomena of language in society

BBC3212 Chinese Phonetics and Phonology

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the study of the history of Chinese sound system and its' development in different historical periods, sounds of language, phonetics and phonology dictionaries, standardization of the Chinese sound system, sound system of Chinese dialect and rhyming structure of Chinese classical poetry

BBC3213 Introduction to Chinese Philology

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers definition, history development of Chinese Scripts, formation of various ancient Chinese scripts and its changes, formation of various modern Chinese characters and its functions in sentences and proverbs and applications of Chinese dictionary

BBC3214 Psycholinguistics

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the study on scope of psycholinguistics; language center; theories and stages of language acquisition; understanding a message; reading; language presentation and linguistics; first language and second language acquisition; language and thought; development of Chinese psycholinguistics and its current trend

BBC3216 Chinese Lexicology

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the study of definition, word structure and formation, word meaning and word meaning formation, semantics, essential elements of the word in modern Chinese, idioms, development and standardization of words, comprehension and usage, new meaning of words and finding word meaning from dictionary, and new issues in the field of lexicology

BBC3217 Research Methodology in Chinese

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the research theory on language, linguistics and literary research concepts, types of research, research methods, research design and procedures, statistics and statistical analysis, preparation and outline of research proposal and research instruments

BBC3221 Introduction to Sinology

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the concept, content, and method of categorization of Sinology. The development of Sinology, prominent Sinologist and their works will also be studied. Selected works from the categories of Jing, Shi, Zi and Ji will also be analyzed

BBC3222 Classical Chinese Language

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the usage of ordinary words, particles, characteristic andthe application of classical Chinese Language. The development of writing structure, variations and differences of ordinary words in classical and modern Chinese language also will be discussed

BBC3223 Modern Chinese Language

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the knowledge of phonology, philology, lexical, grammar, rhetoric and the development of modern Chinese language, and method of analysis of modern Chinese language

BBC3224 Introduction to Literature

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers definitions, literary concepts, intrinsic and extrinsic elements of literature. The introduction of genre includes poetry, fiction, prose and drama. The school of thoughts, theory and literary criticism will also be introduced to examine their influence and function on the development of literature. Appreciation of literary works will be carried out to utilize literary knowledge that has been learned

BBC3227 Comparative Modern Literature: Mahua-Malay

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the definition and concept of comparative literature generally and the development of both literary tradition. Compare of extrinsic and intrinsic theme, character and characterisation, and the perceptions of both parties regarding the issues of nation building will also be examined. This course also introduced several prominent writers and their works as well

BBC3228 Rhyming Proses in Pre-Qin and Han

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course introduces history, sources, forms and creation theories of rhyme proses from pre-Qin era to Han dynasty. The course also analyses selected works of rhyme proses in terms of content, theme, structure and artistic characteristics

BBC3229 Historical and Philosophical Prose of Pre-Qin

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course introduces great works in Chinese philosophy and history during pre-Qin era and Han dynasty. The backgrounds, thoughts, literary styles and structure of the texts are compared. The course analyses selected works and discusses their influence on classical Chinese literature

BBC3230 Poetry of Tang and Song Dynasties

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the study of various kinds and characteristics of poetry created in the Tang and Song dynasties, appreciating selected poems and composing poem based on the structure of classical poetry

BBC3231 Prose of Tang and Song Dynasties

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the study of prose in the Tang and Song dynasties, comparison will be done on the backgrounds, thoughts structure, styles of writing, and aesthetical value of selected works

BBC3232 Classical Chinese Fiction

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the study of characteristics, types, forms and style of writing of classical Chinese fiction in different periods from Pre-Qin to Qing dynasties

BBC3233 Selected Classical Chinese Novel

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the study of selected classical Chinese novel in Ming and Qing dynasties, characteristics, types, forms and style of writing of selected classical Chinese novel, background, theme, thought, plot, characterisation, writing style, and aesthetic value of the selected work

BBC3234 Cultural Linguistics

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the definition, cultural concept and its significance as well as methodology in the related field. It also discusses cultural influences towards language and thoughts, cultural word formation in various aspects and its implications, the use of cultural words in Chinese dialects and its implications, language and cultural contact and its implications in the field of cultural linguistics

BBC3235 Contemporary Chinese Literature

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the discussion of defination, time span and characteristics of contemporary Chinese literature in the context of nasionalism, globalization and transnational phenomenon, prominent writers and selected texts in contemporary Chinese literature in mainland China, Taiwan,

Hong Kong, Malaysia, Europe and North America will be discussed

BBC3236 Linguistic Typology

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers aspects on the study of typology linguistics theory; the relationship between linguistic typology and universal language in phonetics, morphology and syntax; factors which contribute to universal language; the application of linguistic typology in foreign language teaching and learning, as well as in second language teaching and learning

BBC3237 Pragmatics

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers aspects on the study of pragmatics theories; elements in pragmatic studies; the principles in social interaction; the language behaviour; pragmatics analysis in daily conversation; factors contribute to social pragmatics; the application of pragmatics in language teaching and learning

BBC3413 Chinese Prose Writing

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the study of definition, function and types of prose, history of its development, forms and issues, trends and theories, important elements in prose development, analysis of model texts, theory and technique of prose writing, as well as creative prose writing

BBC3415 Writing of Modern Chinese Fiction

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the definition, concept and a brief introduction to modern Chinese fictions, types and nature of the genre, content, theme, form, structure, writing styles and techniques of expression of selected ficarabtions, as well as fiction writing

BBC4106 Malaysian Chinese Socio-Cultural Studies

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers definitions and general concepts of culture, background of various Chinese socio-cultural phenomena in Malaysia, such as division of the ethnic group based to their different dialects, the history of Chinese guilds and modern associations, formation of the Chinese new villages, Chinese education, as well as Mahua-non Mahua cultural interaction

BBC4903 Industrial Training

12 (0+12)

Prerequisite: None

In this course, students will be exposed to real working environment in industries/organizations. Training includes application of the theoretical and practical aspects that have been studied with current practices in the workplace. Problem solving and communication skills are also emphasized

BBC4959 Final Year Research Project

4(0+4)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the preparation of proposal, implementation and scientific writing of research project. Scientific approach to generate data systematically through appropriate design, data collection and analysis are emphasized

BBD3101 Historical Survey of Germany

3(3+0)

BBD3202 German for Business 1

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers communicative skills in German business, business writing skills and business negotiation in German

BBD3203 German for Tourism

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers specific lexical items and linguistic structures in the fields of tourism and hotel studies, and the study of the main tourist attractions in Malaysia and Germany in order to develop students' communicative competency through oral exercises

BBD3204 German for Science and Technology

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers German vocabulary for academic, technical and medical purposes, reading and writing skills in academic, technical and medical German and the practice of the use of German specialized dictionaries

BBD4205 German as a Second Language

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the theory of acquiring German as a foreign language, learning methods of German, development of assessment instruments and learning strategies

BBD3207 Research Methodology in German

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers topics related to concepts, types and methods and procedures in German language and linguistic research, statistical analysis and preparation of research proposal

BBD3208 Introduction to German Linguistics

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers analysis of the phonetic, morphologic and syntactic structure of German as well as on the analysis of main elements of paragraph and text structures

BBD3212 German Grammar

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers grammar study advanced level in the field of morphological and syntactical structures of the German language and to study the differences in the various functions of verb tenses

BBD3213 German for Event Management

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

The course includes the use of language in event management and in appropriate genre, different forms of speech outline and different forms of language used in the organization and the management of formal events

BBD3214 Advanced German for Business

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: MGM3180

This course covers specific communication skills in the management and conduct of German firms. It also covers marketing plan, the management of German firms, through the analysis of the divergence between German and Malaysian business culture

BBD3301 Introduction to German Literature

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the introduction to German literature, the study of selected literary texts and their socio-political frameworks, streams, themes and selected authors

BBD3303 Introduction to German Culture

3 (3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the structures of contemporary German society, cultural phenomena and daily life style in Germany, comparison of similarities and contrasts with Malaysian cultures

BBD3305 German 20th Century Art

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the German 20th century art. It also discusses theoretical the development of expressionist stream, in painting, sculpture and literature

BBD3306 Language and Culture in German Films

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course presents characteristics of language and culture through selected German films. This course emphasis on the appreciation of German films from the aspect of language and culture

BBD3401 Basic Communication Skills

4(2+2)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers oral comprehension and production skills and different levels of language and the sociolinguistic rules of communicating in German

BBD3414 German Language Reading Skills

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers reading skills according to theory and methods in German text reading and, the techniques of deep breathing as to enhance students' reading skills

BBD3415 Introduction to German Language Proficiency for the European 3 (1+2)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers communication skill and writing skill in German language as to develop students' proficiency based on the Common European Framework of References level A1/A2

BBD3416 German Language Proficiency for the European Framework B1/B2

3 (1+2)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers communication skills in German to develop students' proficiency levels based on the Common European Framework of References level B1/B2

BBD3417 Translation of Texts 2

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers a deeper study of the techniques of translation through practical exercises and the use of texts of more complex and varied structures

BBD4403 Translation of Texts 1

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers translation theory and practice of written texts, exercises in translating a variety of short German

BBD3404 German Language I

4(2+2)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the bases of Jerman syntactical structures, lexical items and phonetical rules through simple speech acts and the use of role plays

BBD3405 Intermediate German Language

4(2+2)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the grammatical structures and vocabulary used in daily conversations through writing activities and text comprehension

BBD3410 Advanced German Language

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the grammatical structures and vocabulary used in various speech acts. Focus is given on explanation of tacit cultural traits

BBD4211 Writing Skills in German

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the development writing strategies required to communicate efficiently in German language

BBD4409 Advanced Communication Skills

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers advanced oral comprehension and production skills and different levels of language and the socio-linguistic rules of communicating in German

BBD4903 Industrial Training

12 (0+12)

Prerequisite: None

In this course, students will be exposed to real working environment in industries/organizations. Training includes application of the theoretical and practical aspects that have been studied with current practices in the workplace. Problem solving and communication skills are also emphasized

BBD4959 Bachelor Dissertation

6(0+6)

Prerequisite: BBD3207

This course covers the preparation of proposal, implementation and scientific writing of research project. Scientific approach to generate data systematically through appropriate design, data collection and analysis are emphasized

BBF3101 Survey of the History of France

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the study of significant changes in the history of France from the sixteenth to the Fifth Republic with particular emphasis on prominent historical figures

BBF3202 French for Business and Management

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: 300 hours French Language

This course covers specific lexical items used in French business language, the composition of French business and management, French business culture by analyzing how their business culture diverges from Malaysian's

BBF3203 French for Tourism & Hotel Studies

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers specific lexical items and linguistic structures in the fields of tourism and hotel studies, and the description of main tourist attractions in Malaysia and France in order to develop students' communicative competency

BBF3204 French for Science dan Technology

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers specific lexical items and linguistic structures in science and technology. It also aims to develop students' reading, writing and oral skills through the study of authentic texts on scientific or technological matters

BBF3206 Didactics Of French As A Foreign Language For Young Learners

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course emphasizes on the teaching methods for French as a foreign language for young learners. Relevant teaching tools will be analysed for teaching purposes

BBF4205 Didactics of French as a Foreign Language

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the study of the audiovisual and communicative eras in the teaching of French as a foreign language and on the analysis of some text books. It also aims at introducing to the students the use of new technologies in the teaching of French as a foreign language and discusses various pedagogical strategies

BBF3207 Introduction to French Political System

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the concepts of French political system, by focusing on the historical evolution, institution, prominent figures and the main achievement of the Fifth Republic. The course also relates French political system in relation to other prominent political systems and the Europeen Union

BBF3208 Research Methodology in French

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers topics related to concepts, types and methods and procedures in French language and linguistic research, statistical analysis and preparation of research proposal

BBF3210 French Syntax and Morphology

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the description of the French syntax and morphology together with the study of the various components of a sentence, simple and complex, and their terminology

BBF3211 Introduction To French Sosiolinguistics

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course discusses linguistics changes, which covers disciplines such as historical linguistics, dialectology and relationships between language and society

BBF3212 Introduction to French Discourse Analysis

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the analysis of discourse in the French language using a wide variety of spoken and written texts, the analysis of essential discourse types, and the analysis of discourse in relation to students' needs and practices

BBF3215 Advanced French For Business And Management

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: BBF3202

This course is an advanced course which covers specific communication skills in the management and conduct of French firms. It also covers marketing plan, and the management of French firms

BBF3216 Advanced French For Tourism And Hospitality

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: BBF3203

This course covers communication skills which are specific in the fields of hospitality and hotel studies. Development of solid communicative competency through practical exercises is emphasised

BBF3217 Language Acquisition

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers different theories in language acquisition and language learning and teaching approaches. Universal aspects in language acquisition and cross-linguistic phenomenas will also be discussed

BBF3301 Introduction to French Literature

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the main literary movements, authors and writings from the 16th to the beginning of the 20th century. It also focuses on selected texts with emphasis on analyzing ideas in the social, political and ideological context

BBF3302 Introduction to French Culture

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the study of different components of the behaviour of the French people with particular emphasis on the differences between the French and Malaysian cultures

BBF3304 French Phonetics

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the sound system of French language based on the international phonetic alphabet, articulatory phonetics, phonetics transcription of French language, segmental sound units, phonemes and distinctive features, theory and application of generative phonology of French language

BBF3403 Translation of Texts 1

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers studies translation of French texts to Malay and English. It also explores the basic techniques of translation to produce a coherent and precise translation

BBF3404 French Language 1

4(2+2)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the bases of French syntactical structures, lexical items and phonetical rules through the use of various oral and written texts. It also covers basic communicative skills through simple speech acts and the use of role plays

BBF3405 French Language 2

4(2+2)

Prasyarat: BBF3404

This course covers the grammatical structures and vocabulary used in daily conversations. It also focuses on writing activities and text comprehension through the use of authentic documents

BBF3410 French Language 3

3(1+2)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the grammatical structures and vocabulary used in speech acts in a simple and coherent way. It also focuses on explaining further tacit cultural traits through the study of authentic documents

BBF3413 Communication Skills

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers oral comprehension and production skills and different levels of language. Sociolinguistic rules of French communicationis discussed

BBF3415 Introduction to French Language Proficiency for European Framework 3 (1+2)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers basic oral and writing skills in French to develop students' proficiency levels based on the Common European Framework of References level A1/A2

BBF3416 French Language Proficiency For European Framework B1/B2

3(1+2)

Prerequisite: BBF3415

This course covers communication skills in French to develop students' proficiency levels based on the Common European Framework of References level B1/B2

BBF4408 Comparing Languages through Translation of Texts

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers a deeper study of the techniques of translation by comparing languages through practical exercises and the use of texts of more complex and varied structures

BBF4401 Reading-Writing Skills for European Framework B1/B2

4(2+2)

Prerequisite: None

This course develops reading strategies needed to fully understand a text. Emphasis is given on extracts from newspapers, magazines and reports based on Common European Framework of References level B1/B2. Strategies to produce a coherent text is also discussed

BBF4412 Oral and Writing Practices

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the development of oral and writing strategies required to communicate efficiently in a French environment with particular emphasis on the development of confidence and spontaneity

BBF4903 Industrial Training

12 (0+12)

Prerequisite: None

In this course, students will be exposed to real working environment in industries/organizations. Training includes application of the theoretical and practical aspects that have been studied with current practices in the workplace. Problem solving and communication skills are also emphasized

BBF4959 Bachelor Dissertation

6(0+6)

Prerequisite: BBF3208

This course covers the preparation of proposal, implementation and scientific writing of research project. Scientific approach to generate data systematically through appropriate design, data collection and analysis are emphasized

BBQ3201 Arabic Literary Criticism

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the definition of literary criticism, history of literary criticism and its prominent scholars, emergence, development and types of Arabic literary criticism. This course also focuses on characters and roles of critics and the relation between criticism and literature development

BBQ3202 Comparative Literature: Arabic-Malay

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers concept of comparative literature and related matters, types of Arabic and Malay literature (forms, characters and themes) and some prominent writers and their selected works

BBQ3301 Pre-Islamic Arabic Literature

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers emergence and development of pre-Islamic literature, characteristics, genres, themes and examples of significant literary works of this period

BBQ3304 Abbasid Arabic Literature

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers development of Abbasid Arabic literature, stages of prose and poetry development, literary themes and schools, literature genre during Abbasid period

BBQ3305 Modern Arabic Literature

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers Arabic literature from 18th century until present, renaissance factor, prose and poetry features, theme, school of thought, genre, figure and leadership in modern Arabic literature

BBQ3306 Andalusian Literature

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers background of Andalus, brief history of Andalus, politics, civilization and socioculture in golden period of Andalus, development of Andalus Arabic literature, genres, themes and introduction of prominent Andalus literary scholars

BBQ3310 Sufism Literature

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers the history of sufis literature, genre, themes, specific characteristics, and style of sufis literature, and prominent authors and pioneers in developing sufis literature

BBQ3315 Early Islamic and Umayyad Arabic Literature

3(3+0)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers development of Arabic literature, poetry and prose in the early age of Islamic and Umayyad era, characteristic and stage of development, theme and some examples of significant literary works of both periods

BBQ3414 Translation of Literary Texts

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers theoretical concepts of literary translation, cultural transfer, form and genre, process and product of Arabic literary translation, commercialization, translation of major Arabic literary work, and Arab literary translation in poetry and prose

BBQ3417 Reading Of Modern Arabic Prose Text

3(2+1)

Prerequisite: None

This course covers history of emergence and development of Arabic prose, its genre, dominant features, issue, themes and different schools of thought in creating Arabic prose
