Visa Information

KA107 Erasmus+ International Credit Mobility (ICM) is categorized under staff mobility (attachment). The programme is considered as a short term official visit to UPM which does not require any specific visa for entry. However, prior to entry, you are required to do the following items:

- a. Fully vaccinated travellers and children aged 12 and above below are exempted from pre-departure and on-arrivals tests.
- b. Partially or not vaccinated travellers must take an RT-PCR test 2 days before departure and a supervised RTK-Ag test within 24 hours of arrival. They will also have to quarantine for 5 days.
- c. Covid-19 insurance is no longer required for all travellers entering Malaysia

Quarantine Information

Please be informed that starting from 1st May 2022, quarantine requirements upon entry will no longer imposed provided that each traveller fulfill the requirements enforced by the Ministry of Health Malaysia. Please take note that this rule is subject to any development of current situation.

Quarantine Information

TEST AND RELEASE PROCEDURE FOR COVID-19 POSITIVE CASES FROM 1 MAY 2022



- COVID-19 positive cases must quarantine for 7 days
- However, they can be released earlier if they tested negative on Day-4

Procedure



1 Undergo a supervised (physical or virtual) RTK-Ag COVID-19 test on Day-4 of quarantine



2 Test result will be uploaded to MySejahtera by the medical practitioner



3 If tested negative with the result reflected on MySejahtera, patient may end quarantine



4 If tested positive, patient must complete 7 days of quarantine



5 No further test required after Day-7

COVID-19 SOP RELAXATIONS FROM 1 MAY 2022



MASKS

- **Mandatory indoors** including public transports and e-hailing rides
- **Optional when outdoors** but encouraged in crowded places. High risk individuals are also encouraged to wear a mask.

PHYSICAL DISTANCING

- **No longer required**
- Encouraged when not wearing a mask

MYSEJAHTERA CHECK-IN AND VACCINATION STATUS

- **Check-in is no longer required**
- Entry to premises are allowed regardless of vaccination status except those with 'High Risk' status or under HSO

COVID-19 POSITIVE (TEST AND RELEASE)

- By default, COVID-19 positive cases are required to quarantine for 7 days. However, under Test and Release, they will have an option to **undergo a supervised RTK-Ag test on the 4th day**. If tested negative, they may be released from quarantine

TRAVEL

- **Fully vaccinated travellers and children aged 12 and below** are exempted from pre-departure and on-arrival tests
- Partially or not vaccinated travellers must take an RT-PCR test 2 days before departure and a supervised RTK-Ag test within 24 hours of arrival. They will also have to quarantine for 5 days
- **COVID-19 insurance is no longer required for all travellers entering Malaysia**

NEGATIVE LIST

- The National Security Council's **negative list (banned activities)** is no longer applicable. All economic sectors are allowed to operate from 15 May 2022

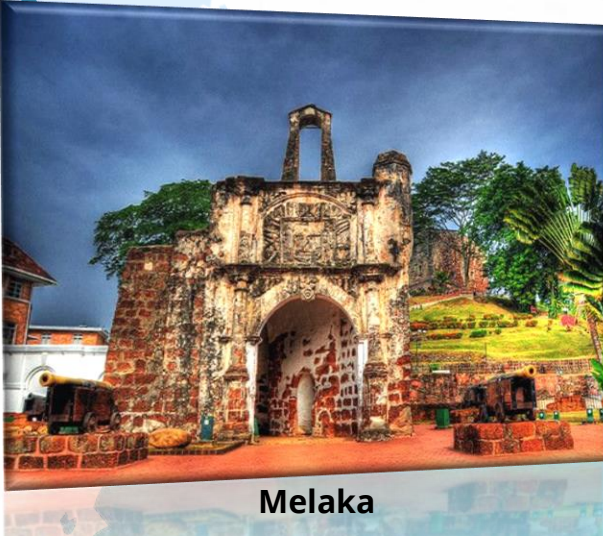

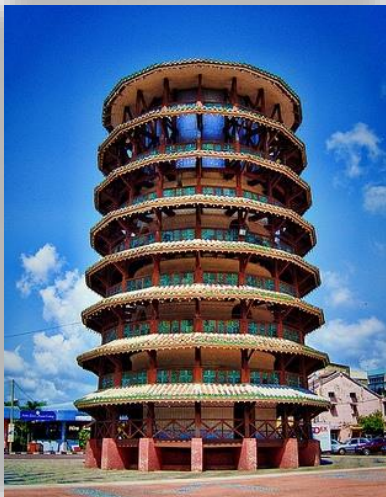
