

UPDATE ON THE STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURES FOR NEW INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS DURING AND AFTER COVID-19 PANDEMIC MOVEMENT CONTROL ORDER

6th May 2021

1. NEW INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS WHO ARE CURRENTLY OUTSIDE MALAYSIA :

Effective 6th May 2021, all international students (except those coming from restrictions countries) may enter Malaysia to continue their studies. Please be informed that holders of dependant passes are still not allowed to enter Malaysia.

As part of the eVAL application process, students must:-

- 1. Fill in the 'Declaration of Accommodation' form (<u>https://forms.gle/kKFxGSBPR6APzVUz5</u>)
- 2. Submit the 'Declaration for Commencement of Online Classes' (applicable only for eVAL application that has been submitted before 1st January 2021). This declaration will be provided by Putra International Centre (i-PUTRA)
- 3. Ensure the validity of a student's passport must be at least 18 months (students are recommended to renew their passport if the validity is less than 18 months).
- 4. Please take note that the Declaration of Accommodation and the Declaration for Commencement are only required to be filled in by applicants who wish to continue the eVAL issuance process to enter Malaysia.
- 5. For students who want to **continue the online classes** and does not need to enter Malaysia, The EMGS approval letter will still be valid until the issuance of the eVAL.

Kindly note that EMGS will not proceed to submit an application for an eVAL approval if the above conditions are not fulfilled.

2. eVAL EXTENSIONS :

Students who have received their VAL but are not able to enter Malaysia within the VAL validity period due to COVID19 travel restrictions may submit their VAL extension request via e-mail to visapass_val@upm.edu.my
